


Instructions:

1. **Follow door installation instructions** for Series 'A', 'AA', or 'B'. Ensure to leave at least 35mm additional clearance for windclips when mounting door brackets. Replace track installations instructions with the following steps.




DOOR WIDTH / DOORWAY CLEAR OPENING + 100mm

- 2. Slide brackets onto track from the bottom. One bracket per wind clip (See Table 1)
- 3. **Position tracks in place** (as per Figure 1) and fasten at top and bottom. When positioning the track, push inwards so that it touches the windclips, mark the location on the wall top and bottom and move the track back 1-2mm. The plated windclip should be covered by the track when viewed from straight on.



5. Brackets must be installed with a **fastener in the centre of the slot** (Figure 3) of every bracket to allow the track to potentially travel in the worst case scenario of an extreme wind event.
